




Capital Roads Program

- This program includes roadway renewal projects including overlays and reconstructions as well as annual laneway rehabilitations.
- Currently held by Al-Terra Engineering
- •Up for Renewal in 2027

Community Development Program


- This program includes community driven projects such as park and recreation upgrades, multiway, trail systems, and art installations.
- Currently held by Al-Terra Engineering
- Up for renewal in 2026

Capital Utilities Program

- This program includes any upgrade and repairs required to the City of Leduc's storm, sanitary and water networks. This includes mainline and lateral liners, spot repairs and replacements.
- Currently held by Select Engineering
- Up for renewal in 2025.

Capital Utilities Program

- Pressure Relief Valves
 - Divide the existing water system into northern and southern zones.
 - Installation of four Pressure Relief Valves (PRVs) along Black Gold Drive.
 - Closure and upgrading of existing water lines.
 - PRVs to be an underground vault style system
 - Integrate into the City's SCADA system



Capital Utilities Program

- 2026 Lindsford Park Water Main Upgrades
 - Upsize the waterline to the Lindsford Park School to maintain required fire flows.



Engineering Master Plans

All master plans are on a 7-year update schedule

Water Master Plan

- Completed by AECOM in 2020
- Next update planned for 2027

Storm Master Plan

- Completed by AECOM in 2024
- Next update planned for 2031

Sanitary Master Plan

- Completed by Cole Engineering in 2019
- Next update planned for 2026

Transportation Master Plan

- Awarded to McElhanney and in progress for completion in 2025
- Next update planned for 2032
