

- Journey lines help **identify** motivations, skills, experience, strengths and values as well as **summarize** your background and journey.






#### **Your Journey Line**

It keeps us grounded when things get tough and aligns our leadership with meaning.






#### Pillar 2: Authenticity

It's not about holding power, it's about preparing others to thrive when we're no longer there.






